Actions for a Healthy, Productive Workforce



Kansas is one of seven states to receive a child abuse prevention grant from the Center for Disease Control, which helps fund a state level coalition, K-Pop, and the local Wichita Coalition for Child Abuse Prevention, which is staffed through KCSL and the WSU Community Engagement Institute. A key prevention strategy is providing economic support to promote family stability. The CDC also identified Adverse Childhood Experiences (ACES) as a significant barrier to a healthy workforce. ACES are traumatic experiences birth to 18 in the areas of abuse, neglect and household dysfunction which have a lasting impact on health and well-being. This presentation describes the supportive policies and practices that employers can implement to ensure family friendly workplaces and a productive workforce.
