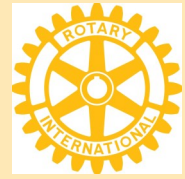

NO MEETING - FEB. 21st Feb. 28th - Noon - LIVE at BOTANICA! Tony Mattivi "Hate in the Heartland"

Tony Mattivi is the retired federal prosecutor who prosecuted the three domestic terrorists who plotted to bomb a Somali apartment complex in Garden City Kansas.

In the spring and summer of 2016, spurred by paranoia and amped-up notions of patriotism—and fueled by anti-Muslim rhetoric from the Far-Right media—four men in southwestern Kansas began plotting a terrorist attack. Their target: the growing Somali immigrant community in their rural corner of the state. But what three of these men did not know was that the fourth was a local man who had infiltrated their homegrown militia as an informant for the FBI. Dan Day, an ordinary citizen of Garden City, became an extraordinary hero. His secretly taped conversations with the militia were pivotal in obstructing their plans and was the lynchpin in their resulting trials and convictions by Assistant U.S. Attorney Tony Mattivi. All three terrorists were sentenced to decades in prison.

Mattivi gives a up close and inside view of this case and the trial that brought these terrorists to justice. Says Mattivi of the trial, "this case changed the way the Department of Justice prosecutes domestic terrorism in the United States".
