Conner's passion for affordable childcare and early childhood education for all drove him to take this position at CCA. He was born and raised in Wichita and after some time away, his hometown called him back. As a father of a two-year-old, he understands the challenges of childcare and is passionate about eliminating those barriers for other parents in Wichita.

Conner Hampton and the Board of Directors are working towards building a new early childhood education center for children and families in downtown Wichita. Center City Academy's mission is to provide a safe, educationally enriched environment at an affordable cost to families of diverse backgrounds. They will provide childcare for children, ranging in age from 6 weeks to 5 years old, on a sliding fee scale that will accommodate a diverse range of income levels and family sizes. With the capacity to serve 100 children daily and provide family programs, CCA will be able to serve and empower Wichita's children, families, employers, and the future.
